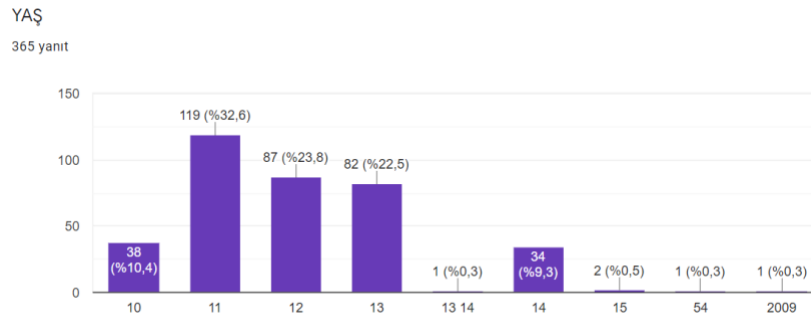

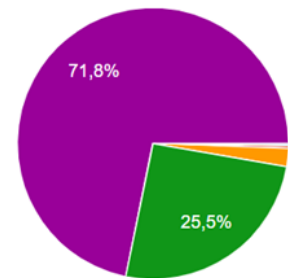
The initial survey of the project was applied three hundred sixty five (365) students in our school via google documents. The results are here:

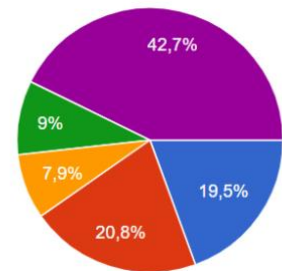
4. How important is it for you to protect the environment?

- e. Very important 262 students %71.8



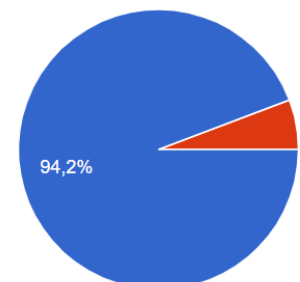
5. What is the most important source of information about environmental protection?

- e. Organizations dealing with these activities 156 students %42



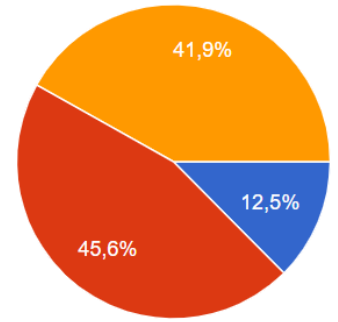
6. Do you know of any signs of current climate change? (global warming, extreme weather events, rising sea levels, shrinking of ice caps, floods, drought)

- b. No. 21 students % 5.8



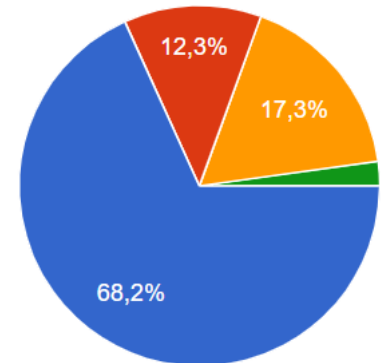
7. If **Yes**, what solutions do you consider necessary to reduce the negative effects:

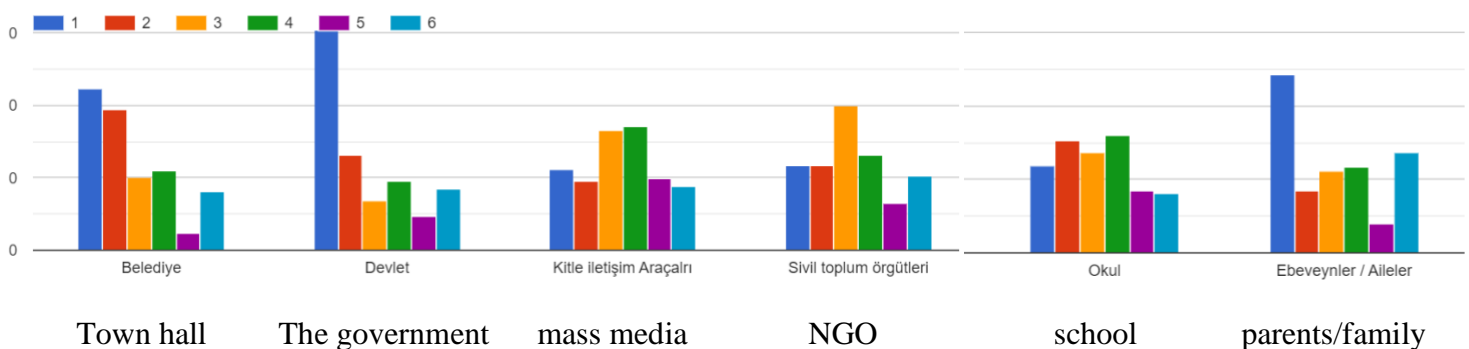
8. Which of the following statements apply to you:

- d. I am not particularly interested in environmental and nature protection 8 students % 2.2



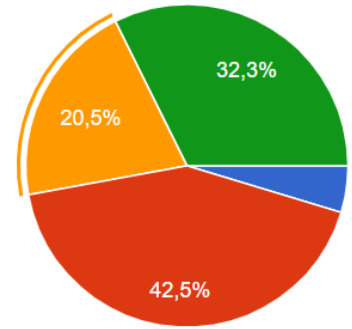
9. In your opinion, who should take care of the protection of the environment and nature - sort the options according to priority:
